SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 SCHEDULE OF RACES

Sunday 6th August

08:00 Transportation sailing to Saltsjöbaden
11:00 Warning signal for the first leg of the day
Two legs scheduled
Base camp: Rånö

Monday 7th August

04:30 Warning signal for the first leg of the day
Three legs scheduled
Base camp: Sandhamn

Tuesday 8th August

04:30 Warning signal for the first leg of the day
Three legs scheduled
Base camp: Nässlingen

Wednesday 9th August

08:00 Warning signal for the first leg of the day
Two legs scheduled
Finish: Outside Hundudden, Stockholm

When all boats have finished a leg, the Race Committee vessel will remove the orange flag. When the Race Committee starting vessel has laid the starting line for the next leg, the orange flag will be hoisted with one sound signal and the warning signal for the next start will follow in approximately 10 minutes.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1 The Race Office is located in the “Race Office Tent” at each base camp.
- 2.2 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board (ONB) on the internet at www.stockholmarchipelagoraid.com
- 2.3 Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flag pole on board the Race Committee starting vessel moored in the harbour of each base camp.
- 2.4 The Race Committee will try to inform all competitors on VHF channel 71 regarding starting times, boats failing to start correctly, any course changes etc. Failure to make a broadcast or to time it accurately will not be grounds for a request for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

3 COURSES AND MARKS (CP)

- 3.1 The courses with check points for each day will be described on the ONB and in a team briefing in the evening the day before.
- 3.2 The positions (WGS 84) and descriptions of all check points are available on the official notice board.

4 TIME LIMITS

- 4.1 There are no time limits, but the Race Committee may decide to shorten a leg at any time for any reason by deleting one or more check points. Boats will be informed orally, via VHF and on an information board. The finish line may be moved to a check point.

5 CHANGES TO THE RACING RULES AND APPENDIX S

- 5.1 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 5.2 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted 1 hour before the warning signal on the day it will take effect. This changes RRS Appendix S 3.1.

5.2 RRS 26 is changed. Races will be started as follows:

Minutes before starting signal	Visual signal	Sound signal	Means
5	Flag with no. 5	One	Warning signal
4	Flag with no. 4*, flag no. 5 removed	One	Preparatory signal
1	Flag with no. 1, flag no. 4 removed*	One long	One minute
0	Flag no. 1 removed	One	Starting signal

*Any starting penalty flag in accordance with RRS 30 will be displayed and removed with the preparatory signal flag.

5.3 RRS Appendix S 10.1 is deleted. See item 4.1.

5.4 Protests shall be e-mailed to the Race Committee on RC@stockholmarchipelagoraid.se and identify

- (a) the protestor and protestee;
- (b) the incident;
- (c) where and when the incident occurred;
- (d) any rule the protestor believes was broken; and
- (e) the name of the protestor's representative.

This changes RRS Appendix S 13.1.
